

AN INDEX OF THE GRAVES IN THE CHURCHYARD OF ST. HILDA'S

The format of the records is as follows:

Number of grave. Name; date of death (age at death); occupation or relationship to others; other information.

Any epitaph, quotation or tribute to the deceased.

The numbers of the graves mark the approximate position of the graves on the accompanying map of the churchyard.

Most of the graves are headstones. Where appropriate, however, graves have been described as:

- i) slabs: horizontal stone blocks
- ii) monuments: more elaborate headstones than are usual
- iii) tombs: rectangular blocks.
